

## The '23 Real Estate Market So Far

The 2022 Real Estate Market in Winnipeg really was a tale of two completely different acts.

In the first half of the year we were dealing with a super-hot sellers market. Homes which in previous years would have been sold in the high 300's, were suddenly dealing with dozens of offers, driving the price up to 500k.

Then, like throwing a light switch, the market went dark around the end of June, beginning of July.

Our little neighbourhood in Southland Park is an excellent illustration of this.

Over the year, 16 houses came to market in Southland Park. Of these, 15 sold and one listing expired.

In the first half of the year, the 6 homes that sold, did so in an average of 8 days each.

During the 2nd half, the 9 homes which sold took an average of 27 days..... like someone threw the light switch.

What happened? Most likely it's the sudden increase in the bank rate, which started to creep up in April/May. Anyone who was pre-approved for a home purchase, most likely had a rate hold on the lower rates until late June, or July.

#### How is 2023 looking?

This year is starting out to be a lot more 'buyer-friendly' than previous spring markets.

On average, Winnipeg has more than double the available listings when compared to last year, and sales are 30-40% lower than in spring of '22.

In Southland Park, we have seen just 2 sales, and both sold at, or just below, list price. Average days on market was just 13.
